The MidSouth Music Institute, Inc. is a local non-profit organization that supports a choral music education program called CoroRio. We currently work with over 150 students in grades 1-12 from public, private, parochial and home schools to "make a better world through the gift of song." It is a tuition based program, but we give \$10,000 in scholarships each year to students who wouldn't otherwise be able to participate and need the *discipline, leadership, confidence and team-building skills that we foster in our students*. **Research shows that a well-rounded education that includes high quality instruction in the arts is key to transforming communities and the young people who will be the leaders of tomorrow.** We also support a community adult program and sponsor professional development workshops for the public and private school music educators in the area as a service to the community. We present several concerts a year and also perform for different community functions, as well as for local nursing homes and hospitals. We recently launched a facility campaign that would allow us to expand our programming to include senior citizens, special needs, and pre-school programs through other music avenues such as keyboard classes, drumming circles, guitar classes, and other instrumental options.

CoroRio is hosting our second annual fundraising dinner, Gala del Rio, on Friday, November 30th, at The Red Barn Hernando. The Mississippi River Chorale and Ictus (our adult groups) are going to provide a concert and dinner entertainment for the evening, in addition to some cabaret style acts, a silent auction, and wine pull. This fundraiser is a vital part of our organization's growth for future endeavors such as our facility campaign and expanded programs for our children and youth.
