Our vision is to transform the lives of children from all ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds by giving them the skills, self-discipline and confidence to succeed in music and in life.















Joelle Norris

Executive & Artistic Director, Founder

Joelle Norris graduated summa cum laude with a BME from Roberts Wesleyan College and a MME from Florida State University and directed choirs at Olean High School (NY) and Olive Branch High School (MS). While teaching in the public school system, Mrs. Norris' choirs were invited to sing at the 2008 Mississippi ACDA/MMEA State convention and the 2010 ACDA Southern Division Convention. Also in 2010, she was honored as a Mississippi STAR teacher. She had the privilege of serving as MSACDA R&S Chair for Women's Choirs in which capacity she coordinated the first Mississippi All-State Women's Choir from 2009-2010 and the ACDA Southern Division Women's Honor Choir in 2010.

In 2012, Joelle and her husband, Reese, co-founded the MidSouth Music Institute, Inc., a non-profit organization that supports a community youth choir, CoroRio, and a community adult choir, Mississippi River Chorale. She currently serves as Executive and Co-Artistic Director for MMI and conducts two of the six choirs. Joelle works from home where she also cares for children, Isabelle, Juliette, and Weston. She was a contributing author for the book, Conducting Women's Choirs: Strategies for Success, and also enjoys serving as a clinician, adjudicator and presenter across the Southeast.



J. Reese Norris

Artistic Director, Founder

J. Reese Norris is director of choirs at Hernando Middle School and is co-founder and co-artistic director of CoroRio. Mr. Norris received degrees from Delta State University and Florida State University, and in 2005 was named Delta State University Music Alumnus of the Year. Norris was the 2017 recipient of MMEA's Music Educator of the Year, the Ernestine Ferrell Lifetime Achievement Award given by the Mississippi Chapter of ACDA, and the Delta State University Educator of the Year Award.

Choirs under his direction have performed at Carnegie Hall, at the National Conference for Middle School Choirs, for the Alabama ACDA Summer Conference, twice for Mississippi ACDA's State Conference, twice for ACDA's Southern Division Conference, at the OAKE National Conference and at the ACDA National Conference. Norris has been honored to serve as a guest clinician across the U.S.

Mr. Norris' compositions have been performed in all-state choirs, at ACDA Conferences, in Carnegie Hall and across the globe. His compositions and arrangements are published by Santa Barbara, Lawson Gould, Colla Voce, G. Schirmer, and MusicSpoke.



Dr. Libby Hearn
Conductor

Elizabeth (Libby) Hearn is Assistant Professor of Choral Music Education at the University of Mississippi (Ole Miss) where she conducts the Women's Glee ensemble and teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in choral music education and conducting.

Prior to joining the faculty at Ole Miss, Dr. Hearn received a Ph.D. in music education from the University of Alabama where she served as assistant conductor of the UA Women's Chorus. She also taught classes in music education, choral methods, and she facilitated the Chamber Choir.

Dr. Hearn is an active conductor, presenter, clinician, and adjudicator. She has presented her research at national, regional, and state conferences and recently conducted the UA Women's Chorus at the Alabama Music Educators Association conference. Her research interests include assessment in the music classroom, singing accuracy, ensemble identity, ACDA history, and job mobility in music education. Her most notable accomplishment is being Mom to Catherine (9) and Andrew (5).



Dr. Don Trott

Donald Trott received his Bachelor of Music Education degree cum laude from Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey. He obtained both the Master of Music degree and Doctor of Musical Arts degree in choral conducting from the University of Oklahoma under the guidance of Dennis Shrock. While at Westminster, he sang under notable conductors such as Leonard Bernstein. Raphael Kublik, Eric Leinsdorf, Joseph Flummerfelt, and Dennis Shrock. Following degree work he taught at Lawton Senior High School (Lawton, Oklahoma), Rogers University (Claremore, Oklahoma), and Longwood University (Farmville, Virginia). Dr. Trott has been the director of choral activities at the University of Mississippi since 2002. Dr. Trott is a pastpresident of the Southern Division of ACDA. He is editor of a new book titled Conducting Men's Choirs, published by GIA Publications. He is now serving as the co-conductor of CoroFuente.



Terrell Hall
Sight-singing & Music Theory Instructor, Conductor

Terrell Hall graduated from the University of Mississippi in 2013 with a BME in Vocal Music Education and a MM in Choral Conducting in 2015. While at the University of Mississippi, Terrell was a member of the Concert Singers, Men's Glee, the Graduates ensemble, and the University of Mississippi Gospel Choir. Terrell began his teaching career in the New Albany Public School District. His choirs were very successful in both district and state choral adjudications. Terrell is currently in his third year as Director of Choral Activities at Olive Branch High School, and the Director of Elementary Music at First Presbyterian Church in Oxford.MS. Terrell is a member of the American Choral Directors Association, the National Association for Music Education. and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Mr. Hall also serves as the MMEA High School Division District 2 Chair and the District 2 Honor Choir Chair. He currently serves as the Instructor of Sight-Singing and Music Theory, a cappella pop ensemble conductor, and associate director of CoroFuente.

Justin Wadkins is in his fourth year as director of choirs at DeSoto Central High School where his responsibilities include teaching five choral ensembles.

Wadkins holds the Master of Music degree in choral conducting from The University of Mississippi as well as the Bachelor of Music degree in music education from The University of Mississippi. Under his direction, the DeSoto Central High School choirs have consistently earned superiors at festivals and competitions as well as being named Best in Class ensembles. Recently, the DeSoto Central Chorale was selected to perform at the 2020 MSACDA-MMEA convention.

In 2015, he was a part of the world premiere of the new opera, Hamlet: Prince of Denmark which was performed in Oxford, MS, and in Prague, Czech Republic. He was inducted into both Phi Kappa Phi and Phi Kappa Lambda honors organizations at the University of Mississippi.

Justin is a member of the American Choral Directors Association and the National Association for Music Educators. He is currently serving as the Associate Director of Mississippi River Chorale.
